David Blandford is a professor of agricultural and environmental economics at the Pennsylvania State University. He was formerly a division director at the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development and a professor at Cornell University. He was president of the Agricultural Economics Society (U.K.) in 2010/11. He teaches courses in agribusiness at Penn State and conducts research into food and agricultural policies, including their environmental, trade, and rural development aspects. Blandford has served as a consultant for a range of international organizations including the Food and Agriculture Organization, the International Food Policy Research Institute, the OECD, and the World Bank.
