Kjersti Fløttum is Professor of French linguistics at the Department of Foreign Languages, University of Bergen, where she teaches text theory and discourse analysis. She headed the Bergen Summer Research School (BSRS) 2008-2011. Her general research fields are related to text and genre theory with a special focus on linguistic polyphony (multivoicedness) and dialogism in scientific, political and climate change discourse. She is head of the multidisciplinary project LINGCLIM: *Linguistic representations of climate change discourse and their individual and collective interpretations*. Fløttum is co-author of the book *Academic Voices* (2006) and has published extensively in international journals including *Journal of Pragmatics*, *Journal of Language and Politics*, *Language & Communication*, *Climatic Change*.
