Introduction to Qualitative methods, interview and analysis

Objectives:

The course features an introduction to basic concepts in Qualitative Methods, especially interviews and analysis. By the end of the course, the participants should be able to apply various types of analysis on qualitative data, and to interpret and report of the results from such analyses.

The course focuses on different types of interviews like in depth interview and focus group interview. However, the main focus will be an introduction to and practical training with different ways of analysing qualitative data, including also a brief introduction to the software program NVivo 9.

Required prerequisites: Phd. Students at the Faculty of Psychology, University of Bergen, and Uni Health can attend.

Learning Requirements: No former experience with qualitative analysis is required, but the candidate / participants ought to bring their own data (transcriptions) to class to use in the practical part of the course.

Tutorial registration: The candidates / participants must sign up for the course 14 days in advance. The maximum number of participants is 15.
